

Lift Ticket Inclement Weather/ Terms & Conditions

Greek Peak Mountain Resort is an outdoor facility and will operate as usual in rain and snow. However, we may be required to delay or shut down operations due to high winds, ice, thunder, lightning or other dangerous weather conditions.

Lift Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable once purchased. Future promotions are independent of this offering. No refunds for any reason other than unprepared/unwillingness to ski due to inherent risks within the sport, including but not limited to: sickness, injuries, health problems, weather conditions or natural disasters.

Lift Tickets are for the ticket holder's exclusive use only. Use by another person can result in revocation of your ticket without refund and potential theft of services charges for unauthorized user.

Lift Tickets must be present on the ticket holder to gain access to ski lift. Your Go Pass Card must be secured on your person and in a location that can be read by the gates for every lift boarding occasion.

Lift Tickets are subject to a \$5 fee. The Go Card technology requires a \$5 fee that covers the purchase and encoding of the card. The Go Pass can be reloaded for each ticket purchased throughout the season.

If your Lift Ticket is lost or stolen, you must notify Guest Services at once. A replacement fee of \$5 will be charged to process a new Go Pass for your daily ticket.

Ski area regulations are enforced in accordance with the New York State General Obligations Law, Article 18 and 12 NYCRR Part 54, "Safety in Skiing Code." Any misuse, fraudulent use, misconduct or nuisance caused by the pass holder or failure to follow New York State law may result in revocation without refund or other considerations. Greek Peak Mountain Resort's management reserve the right to revoke Lift Tickets depending upon the severity of the infractions.

Conditions of Purchase

Greek Peak Mountain Resort reserves the right to change opening and closing dates, operating hours, number of days in the week open, restrict access to any open lift and/or terrain at any time based on weather, snow, crowds, capacity restrictions, special events or any other condition or reason. Greek Peak Mountain Resort also reserves the right to determine the number of lifts in operation or area available for use at any given time based on snow, weather or other condition or reasons. A minimum number of operating days is not guaranteed.

An RFID-enabled Go Pass Card will be issued for each Ticket purchased. This Go Pass serves as your lift ticket for the day or consecutive days if a multi-day ticket option is purchased. Your Go Pass Card must be secured on your person and in a location that can be read by the gates for every lift boarding occasion. It is recommended that your pass be placed somewhere between waist height and shoulder height (or on helmet for children). Do not place your Go Pass in a wallet or near a cell phone or other RFID-enabled cards; this will prevent the RFID card from being read properly.

Age at time of purchase will determine eligibility for all lift ticket types. A free lift ticket will be issued to those 6 years of age and under, with the purchase of another ticket. Junior Lift Tickets are available for those 14 years of age and under. Adult Lift Tickets are available for those 15 years of age and older. Proof of age may be required.

Verification will be required for all discount types. This includes, but is not limited to, proof of full-time status for college discounts, proof of service for qualified hero discounts, proof of membership for qualified club discounts, proof of employment for qualified business discounts.

Greek Peak Mountain Resort assumes no responsibility for personal items lost, stolen or damaged while on property. This includes, but is not limited to, lost or stolen skis, boards and equipment, damage to equipment while using terrain park features, damage to outerwear from lift grease, etc.

All ticket purchasers must sign the Lift Ticket Terms & Conditions digitally through a waiver system before receipt and/or use of Season Pass. If purchasing online, a signature is required on the Lift Ticket Terms & Conditions, which is presented immediately following completion of your payment. If purchaser does not have access to the internet, Greek Peak Mountain Resort will provide access to a digital device where the purchaser can sign the Lift Ticket Terms & Conditions in person.
